- ▶ Teknaf: Solidarites INGO will provide support to UNO and coordinate work in Teknaf host communities.

Challenges:

- ▶ Additional pressure on already scarce water resources, especially in Teknaf
- ▶ Adequate land for Waste management and decongestion
- ▶ High contamination at source & Household level due to poor water quality & unsafe hygiene
- ▶ Sustainable Solutions: Moving from small short- term assistance to medium and long term and availability of long term funding for development projects
- ▶ Small number of partners in host communities with already over stretched capacity
- ▶ Lack of space for construction of new facilities
- ▶ As part of common pipeline, need to boost up the customs clearance for water purification tablet supplies
