





Awareness and Sensitization in community level

- On 10-12 March Total 4.5 lakh leaflets printed and distribution with orientation completed by 15 March
 - -Department of Health Prevention's message on preventing the virus
 - -The icddr,b messages,
 - About Self Quarantine to protect the spread out
 - -World Health Organization's Relief from mental stress,
 - -How to stay home quarantine, the punishments if home quarantine isn't done properly were distributed. –
- Leaflet distributed to:
 - -1,35,700 member-participants of micro finance programs,
 - -In 237 union parishads, 51 upazila parishads, 9 zilla parishads,
 - In 539 religious institutions,
 - -In 434 primary schools, 280 high schools and colleges and 299 madrasas, and
 - District and upazila offices, and health complexes.
- Total coverage approximately 8.7 million population



Awareness and Sensitization in community level

- On 20 and 28 March, to raise awareness of the Rohingyas, 1.50 lakh leaflets were printed in Burmese Language
- Distributed to 37 camps and 77 camp mosques with group discussions.

Total coverage approximately 3.50 lakh Rohingya





Survey on Awareness in Coastal Areas

COAST conducted this survey among the lower wage earners in 2 Divisions (Chattogram and Barishal), 2 districts (Cox's Bazar and Bhola), 2 Upallizas (Charfession and Ukhiya), 2 Unions (North Jaliapalong, Ukhiya and Charmanika, Charfession) and in 2 Char area (Kutubdia char and Kukrimukri char). Total 250 sample were interviewed
