## Distribute biscuits to students' homes

To prevent the spread of the global pandemic corona virus, the Government of Bangladesh announced the indefinite closure of all types of institutions from march 18, 2020. At this time students are being deprived of the desired nutrition as they cannot come to school, therefore considering the nutritional needs of the students, a decision was taken by the Ministry of primary and Mass Education of the Government of the people's Republic of Bangladesh.

The COAST School feeding programme office made distribution plans for the distribution of office biscuits as per the letter and instructions given by the Department of primary Education.

After the biscuit distribution plan was approved by the Upazila Nirbahi Officer and the Upazila Education Office and the consultation with the head teachers, the staff of the COAST started working towards the implementation of this objective. During the school closure, COAST staff delivered 30 packets of biscuits to each students in their respective work areas, according to the school teacher's catchment area. The students were very happy to receive the biscuits.
