JUSTICE NEWS in survival strategies of coastal poor



COAST Foundation is executing a project called "access to justice in the community" with the technical assistance of GIZ Bangladesh beginning in July 2021. The COAST Foundation is continuing this initiative in Bangladesh's Chattogram and Barisal regions. This project aims to provide legal aid to the underprivileged and poor members of our society. The project's goal is to establish justice rights for persons who are gender diverse and minorities. Restorative justice meetings, mediation, referral, diversion, and a legal aid clinic will all be used to provide them with legal assistance.

The name of a great opportunity to get legal aid services for the beneficiaries is COAST-Ashrafuzzaman Khokon, Chairman, Vorpasha Union.

On 29th January 2022, the opening of legal aid clinic under "Access to Justice" project was held at Vorpasha Union, Barisal. COAST Foundation, GIZ Bangladesh and NLASO jointly organized the inauguration program. In this inauguration program, the chief guest's speech was given by Mr, Md Golam Sorwar, Secretary, Law and Justice department of Law, Justice and parliament ministry.

He said, the effort is aimed at providing legal supports at all level. It is hoped that this project will establish the justice of of the backward people of society.

Dispute resolving through Mediation

We are resolving the disputes through the respected persons of union/ward under the "Access to Justice at Community" Project. In the total 15 unions of two districts, 117 cases are solved by this mediation. In which, Barisal solved 48 cases and Chattogram solved 69 cases.

Referral and Diversion

Social safety net and legal issue referral for the disadvantaged people are arranged in two district, in which total referral was 72. Barisal referred 43 cases, where as Chattogram referred 29 cases.

To lessen the litigation few cases are diverted to society from Thana, Fari and Court, and the total diversion of cases are in number of 6. In which, Barisal diversion 2 cases and Chattogram diversion 4 Cases.

Successfully dispute resolve by RJ Meeting

15 Disputes were resolved in RJ processes in 15 Union of Two district of project with the goal of living peacefully In the society of victims and accused and lessen the crimes by Positive thinking in keeping with the ancient system of local area Based Justice system.

In which, Barisal solved 5 cases through RJ and Chattogram Solved 3 cases.

Community Paralegals are conducting courtyard meeting along with home visits to inform people about district legal aid support, old age allowance, widow allowance, disability allowance and so on.
