- ✓ 23 percent of the world's total population,
- ✓ 2 percent of the total global income.
- ✓ 40 percent of the world's poor
- ✓ 35 percent of the world's undernourished.

- ✓ Implementation of Seed Bank and Food Bank
- ✓ Cross Boundary issues
- ✓ Water sharing issues, joint management of river basin
- ✓ Non binding state protocol on Climate migrants, Protecting Agenda of Geneva 2015
- ✓ Joint management of Sundarban
- ✓ Open ocean governance / high sea governance
- ✓ Adaptation and DRR, information sharing and regional cooperation

- ✓ COP 20: Lima Conference: **Negotiation**
- ✓ COP 21: Paris Conference: **Decision (Paris Agreement)**
- ✓ COP 22: Marakeach: **Action or Facilitation**

- ✓ A Detailed Plan of Action/schedule on Financial promise
- ✓ To establish a Roadmap of Paris agreement implementation




Toward COP 22 Marakeach

- ✓ Warsaw International Mechanism, what will be the institutional mechanism along with financial support
- ✓ Where the migration / displacement issue will be integrated, in L&D
- ✓ Loss and damage – report back, what will be the mechanism



Green Climate Fund (GCF)

- ✓ Needed pledge to scale up
- ✓ For LDC access is not easy after maintaining conditions
- ✓ Capacity building effort from CVC countries is needed

Green Climate Fund (GCF)


Our government is more inclined toward loan rather than grant, is it commensurate to future debt sustainability?

INDC/NDC

- ✓ Pledges have to be increased after the review of 2018, so that global warming will be well below 2 degree Celsius
- ✓ Based on those technical and financial support have to be given to developing and LDCs.



Adaptation

- ✓ How NAP is being prepared, it should be based on Right Based Approach and through bottom up process.
- ✓ Country need an internal displacement policy with short and long term actions, otherwise we sill hardly able to validate our claim on climate induced displacement in international level
